



After School Program

Our goal with the “After School Program” is to provide a structured environment.

Our program will greatly enhance your child’s confidence and concentration to improve their grades in school and overall development. Each student is an individual with his or her own rate of learning. We strive to encourage and build each child’s imagination and self-confidence.

We will require each student to do homework for an hour each day. If they do not have homework, they will participate in some educational activity, such as reading. Each student will take Taekwondo classes at no additional charge as part of the program.

A nutritional snack is recommended each day. We will provide transportation from your child’s school and provide a fun, safe educational after-school program. The program is open for students grades K through 8, Monday through Friday, with pick-up time by 6:00pm.

TAEKWONDO training is everyday. Students practice all of their requirements and work at a personal pace to accomplish goals.

ROAR'S CHARACTER BUILDING PROGRAM features monthly themes that make it easier to interact and communicate with our students about the morals and benefits of Taekwondo. We instill the five tenets of Taekwondo (Courtesy, Integrity, Self-Control, Perseverance and Indomitable-Spirit) in our students to lay the foundation for strong moral character. This coupled with Taekwondo's ten student commitments encourages our students to do the right thing, even when no one is watching.

ROAR'S DISCIPLINE POLICY encourages good behavior and development. This is accomplished by rewarding students every week for consistent good behavior, and praise when positive improvement is shown. All students must respect and be mindful of themselves and others; and must not be physically, mentally, or emotionally abusive to other students, instructors or staff at any time. Roar Taekwondo does not tolerate inappropriate behavior of any kind by any student and discipline is usually administered in 1 of 3 ways:

1. **Special Exercises:** The student will be required to do 1-3 different basic exercises (i.e. push-ups, sit-ups, leg lifts, etc) to both strengthen the physical body, and focus the mind.
2. **Verbal Warning:** The student will be taken aside or separated from the group by an Instructor or After School Director, and talked to about their behavior, and how it can be corrected.
3. **Parent Meeting:** The student and parent will have a private conversation with the School Master or School Director about the student's behavior and how it can be corrected. Roar reserves the right to remove any student from the After School program if inappropriate behavior continues.

Program Regulations

Please read thoroughly and initial each box below to confirm that you understand and agree to Roar's Program Regulations.

TOPIC	DESCRIPTION	INITIALS
1PM - 3PM	Roar buses pick up students from neighborhood schools. Currently we transport students within ten (10) miles of Roar Taekwondo. See current school list below.	
3PM - 5:50PM	<p>Students change clothes and eat snacks; you must provide your own snack (healthy preferred, no juice; only water). Educational games and special physical activities during the hours which there are no classes. Children take Taekwondo class daily.</p> <p>Students are required to wear their Dobok (Taekwondo Uniform) to all classes. So it is important to bring it every day.</p>	
PICK-UP TIME (5:50PM - 6PM)	<p>Reading for at least 20 minutes. Structured quiet activities.</p> <p>Pick-up time for students is 6:00PM, with a 10-minute grace period, <u>granted only on the first full week of school</u>. Students that have not been picked up by 6:00PM to 6:30PM will result in a \$25 late fee. Any pickups after 6:30PM will result in a \$5 per minute late fee that must be paid when you pick your child up. Failure to pay will result in transportation and child care services not provided for your child.</p> <p>**Parents, if you are not picking up your child, you must notify Roar before 12:00pm to let us know if your child will be absent for the day or who will be picking up your child. This person MUST have identification and be listed on our authorized pickup form, otherwise we will not be able to release the child.</p>	
EARLY RELEASE DAYS	Roar TKD bus will pick children up early at no extra charge, and above activities will be expanded in order to accommodate for the extra time.	
SCHOOL HOLIDAYS	<p>Roar TKD offers a full day program on most school holidays at no extra charge as long as the tuition is respected and current.</p> <p><i>For example:</i> Teacher workdays, Holidays, Spring/Winter Break.</p> <p>Spring/Winter break discount only applies to the 5-Day/Week plan.</p>	
TESTING	Testing is on the first Saturday of each month at 11:30am, if that day is occupied with another event, testing will be postponed to the next Saturday. Testing fee is \$55 and is not included in the A/S Program. If you are not available, you can choose a private testing for \$85 and those are done on Fridays at 6:00pm.	
HOMEWORK	Is scheduled to take place after Taekwondo class. Students are given assistance when needed, in a supervised environment. When finished, it must be checked by an Instructor. Tutoring is also available.	
REFUNDS	Please understand that we only have a limited number of spots in our After School Program and your payment guarantees your child's place in our program. So we cannot accommodate refunds for any day or week your child is absent from our program. <i>No Exceptions.</i>

TRANSPORTATION	<p>To help us keep your child safe while riding the Roar afterschool bus to our facilities, please ensure they understand the regulations for safe bus/van conduct which include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Respect and Follow the drivers' directions at all times ● Wear your seatbelt and remain seated at all times ● Do not talk on the bus or van or in the parking lot while unloading 	
LATE / DECLINED PAYMENTS	<p>If you are paying Weekly, all payments must be <u>submitted every Friday</u>. Payments not received by Friday will result in a late payment fee of \$25 that must be paid prior to your child's Afterschool Monday pick-up or transportation and child care services cannot be provided for you child.</p> <p>If you are paying Monthly, tuition is due on the 29th of the month. If payment is declined, a \$25 late fee will be charged and transportation and child care services cannot be provided for your child.</p> <p>A fee of \$25 will be charged to all declined payments. It is your responsibility to notify Roar and update the card on file due to expired, lost or new cards.</p> <p>If two (2) payments are missed/declined, your account will be deactivated and your child will be removed from the Afterschool program until your account is back current. If your account is deactivated, an \$85 Registration Fee will be required to re-register your child and is dependent upon availability. <i>No Exceptions.</i></p>	
CANCELLATION	<p>Applicant understands that he/she is enrolling in a required 9-month contract. Should you need to cancel for any reason other than moving more than 30 miles from the school (proof of residency change is required) or death - a one (1) month's full tuition payment will be required. You must cancel, in writing, and fill out our cancellation form at least thirty (30) days prior to your next scheduled payment. if no written cancellation request and cancellation fee are made within thirty (30) days, you will continue to be charged the full monthly tuition amount each month as agreed upon in contract. <i>No Refunds. No Exceptions.</i></p>	
WEAPONS	<p>There are no fees for Weapons class, it is included as part of the A/S program. Students must be Green belt and up to join. Weapons are not included and must be purchased from Roar's store, separately. No outside weapons are allowed.</p>	
SPARRING GEAR	<p>Once a student reaches Yellow belt, sparring equipment is required. You can purchase it as early as High White in preparation for Yellow belt. Sparring equipment must be purchased at Roar's store. No outside equipment is allowed.</p> <p><i>Sparring Gear with Personalized Embroidery - \$265</i> <i>Sparring Gear without Personalized Embroidery - \$245</i></p>

Student Regulations

- Students must remove their shoes before entering the Dojang (workout area.)
- When students enter and leave the Dojang, they are expected to bow to the flags as a gesture of respect.
- Students should bow to Instructors and black belts to show respect for their rank. Students are also expected to bow to other students as a respectful greeting.
- Students are not allowed to bring valuables to Roar. Roar is not responsible for lost or stolen property.
- The start and end of each class begins with a ceremonial bow to the flags and Instructors.
- Students are not allowed to speak inappropriately, slander, or defame Instructors or other students.
- Students are not allowed to practice any technique or Poomse that has not been taught to them by their Instructor.
- Students are not to ask Instructors when they are to test for the next rank. When the Instructor feels the student is ready, the Instructor will invite the student to test.
- If a student's Dobok becomes messed up while in class, the student must turn away from the flags, straighten their uniform and then turn to face the flags again.
- Students must address Instructors, Black Belts, and other students as "Sir/Ma'am" when conversing.
- Roar Taekwondo reserves the right to withdraw any rank students have earned if a student fails to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner, brings dishonor upon the school, or is disrespectful to an Instructor, another student, or Taekwondo as an art.
- Roar reserves the right to remove any student from the program who consistently and intentionally causes discipline problems.

- Applicant understands that if you are paying Weekly, all payments must be submitted every Friday. Payments not received by Friday will result in a late payment fee of \$25 that must be paid prior to your child's Afterschool Monday pick-up or transportation and child care services cannot be provided for you child.
- Applicant understands that if you are paying Monthly, tuition is due on the 29th of the month. If payment is declined, a \$25 late fee will be charged and transportation and child care services cannot be provided for your child.
- Applicant understands that a fee of \$25 will be charged to all declined payments. It is your responsibility to notify Roar and update the card on file due to expired, lost or new cards.
- Applicant understands that if two (2) payments are missed/declined, your account will be deactivated and your child will be removed from the Afterschool program until your account is back current. *No Exceptions.*
- Applicant understands that if your account is deactivated, an \$85 Registration Fee will be required to re-register your child and is dependent upon availability. *No Exceptions.*
- Applicant understands that Pick-up time is by 6:00pm. If you are not picking up your child, you must notify Roar at 704-282-1400 before 12:00pm to let us know if your child will be absent for the day or who will be picking up your child. This person **MUST** have identification and be listed on our authorized pickup form, otherwise we will not be able to release the child.
- Applicant understands that students that have not been picked up by 6:00PM to 6:30PM will result in a \$25 late fee. Any pickups after 6:30PM will result in a \$5 per minute late fee that must be paid when you pick your child up.
